The building that we have is in bad condition, but we hope to soon be able to have the new one; not only is it our desire to have a better building for our comfort, but to see more souls that come to hear the message of our Lord.

Thanks be to God, the health of my son Jahaziel is very good and he is very enthused. Besides home schooling, he has been taking a music course in a school. He has had his first test and, thank God, has passed with a good grade.

My son, Marco Jr., pastor in Pesqueria, Nuevo Leon, has had a great blessing with his daughter, Analy. He is taking her to a school for the blind, and though she is only one year and two months old, they say she is doing activities on a level of children who are older. They scheduled an appointment for him and his wife with a psychologist to help them face life with the difficulties of a blind daughter. The psychiatrist was so happy to see the conviction that they have and the rest that they have found in our Lord Jesus, that she asked him to please give some classes there to encourage other parents of children that are enrolled in the school who are struggling to face their situation.
